MEMORANDUM FOR EXAMINATION.

Note. All men to be completely stripped during examination.

Men presenting any of the following conditions will be rejected :-

Scrofula, phthisis, bronchial or laryngeal disease; palpitation or other disease of heart; defects of vision, voice, or hearing; contraction or deformity of chest or joints; flatfoot or other deformity of foot; abnormal curvature of spine; defective intelligence; hernia; disease of testicle; varicose veins or varicocele, beyond a limited extent; hemorrhoids or other disease of anus; or any disease or physical defect calculated to unfit them for the duties required.

MEASUREMENT OF CHEST.

The candidate will be made to stand erect with his feet together, and to raise his arms over his head. The tape will be carefully adjusted round the chest with its posterior upper edge touching the inferior angles of the scapulæ, and its anterior lower edge the upper part of the nipples. The arms will then be lowered to hang loosely by the sides, and care will be taken that the shoulders are not thrown upwards or backwards so as to displace the tape. The candidate will then be directed to take a deep inspiration several times, and the maximum expansion of the chest will be carefully noted. Fractions of less than half an inch should not be noted.
